Ion Perdicaris of England, formerly of Trenton, has just sold his town house in Tangier, Morocco, "El Minzah," "the beautiful," for the sum of 16,000 pounds, or \$80,000 in our money. It had some eighty rooms. Many Trenton people have been royally entertained there. This must not be confused with "Idonia," Mr. Perdicaris' home on the Mediterranean Sea, a few miles from Tangier, which he still retains. Mr. Perdicaris' present home is an old Tudor Manor House near Chislehurst, England, and is quite near the house in which Napoleon III died in 1871 and where his widow Empress Eugenie still resides. It was built by Sir Francis Walsingham, the prime minister of Queen Elizabeth and here she often visited him during her long reign.
